

Announcement of Mahidol University International College
On the College's Scholarship Awards Policy
Provided by Tobacco Industry B.E. 2550 (2007)

The meeting of administrators no. 4/2007 held on February 27th, 2007 has agreed to disseminate policy of the Commission on Higher Education on providing scholarship from the Tobacco Industry.

The director of Mahidol University International College, therefore, promulgates the Announcement of Mahidol University International College On the College's Scholarship Awards Policy Provided by Tobacco Industry B.E. 2550 (2007) as follows:

1. Academic personnel, supporting academic personnel and students of the College may seek scholarship awards or research funding from the outside organizations except from the tobacco industry or any business organizations relating to tobacco industry either directly or indirectly
2. Academic personnel, supporting academic personnel and students of the College shall support academically to outside organizations such as training, providing advice as well as being consultants except to the tobacco industry or any business organizations relating to tobacco industry in all cases.
3. Academic personnel, supporting academic personnel and students of the College may conduct researches or joint research projects with agencies or organizations which were funded by outside organization except those which were funded by tobacco industry or any business organizations relating to tobacco industry.
